## **PROGRESS!!**

- Conrad Schmitt painter is on-site today, Monday the 29th and Tuesday to take care of touch ups where plaster was cracking.
- Scaffolding removal has begun! See pictures below.
- Air conditioning tubes will be moved to allow for work on the west side of the church.
- Once exterior doors are replaced, we will contact the company who will install the automatic door openers.
- Smithenry Concrete will begin work this week. The first steps will be prepping the area west of the church for the carport/portico including tree and old concrete removal and other necessary dirt work. The day after Picnic, August 5, they will begin pouring concrete and anticipate completing that work within a week. They will also repair the sidewalk on the east side of the church that was damaged when trenching work occurred earlier this year. All timelines are weather permitting.
- Pews are finished!
- Carpet and hardwood flooring are in storage at Dieterich. We are waiting for the tile to arrive.
- Insulation will be blown in the attic the week of July 29.
- Once scaffolding is removed, the windows will be set in the gathering space.
- All lights are installed.
- The sound system will be finished after the scaffolding comes down.
- Smoke and fire detection system will be finished after the scaffolding comes down.
- A request has been submitted to insurance to cover the cost of the "storm windows" replaced and repaired due to fire/heat. This would lower the overall cost for the parish if we do not have to pay for those 8 windows.
- The next parishioner walk through can happen as soon as the subflooring is in place (at least through the middle aisle area). This is a safety concern as the old subfloor is in bad shape.
