CATHOLIC EXTENSION GRANT:

The Family Catechesis ministry is an Award Winner of a prestige grant from Catholic Extension with funding via the Lily Foundation. This is a significant grant award that will benefit our families in our parishes. There will be a "Listening Session" in the near future - most likely early November- with representatives from Catholic Extension attending to meet with our parishioners. There will be more details forth-coming.

PARISH CENTER CLASSROOM RENOVATION:

We have been fortunate to have the remodeled Parish House meeting space as it has been used by numerous groups and for multiple purposes since the fire. The Sisters in Christ group continues to grow with more than 30 women who participate in this group on a regular basis. All the furniture purchased for this purpose is used, in addition to the kitchen chairs, several folding chairs, and the seat in front of the fireplace. At times, someone still must sit on the floor. Before and after meetings, most of the furniture must be moved, regardless of who the group is that meets

there. Removing a wall between two classrooms in the hall is a solution for this "problem" of too many people coming together for the space. In addition, the picnic committee would make use of a meeting space in the hall as that is where their event occurs and supplies are housed, making it easy to check inventory and other items. While larger groups can meet in the hall as is, the acoustics do not work well for group conversation, the furniture must be arranged and rearranged before and after meetings, and the classrooms serve no purpose other than storage if left as is. Ben Niebrugge feels that it is a manageable task to repurpose the space with flooring and drywall work being two of the main expenses. If any parishioner has questions about this, or any topic discussed at Council meetings, we encourage you to attend a meeting and voice your questions. The next meeting will be on October 10, 2024, after mass.
